ArtForm Diana Floor Plan Changes

- 1. Include bulkhead access to cellar at the center/rear of house using a Bilco 55" x 72" bulkhead door
- 2. Replace garage window with 36" door, swings in
- 3. Remove laundry and use that space to expand master closet
 - a. Change master closet to use 24" pocket door located in center of wall between rear wall and right side of bedroom entrance door; slide right to open
- 4. Provide attic access using 22.5" x 54" pull-down stairs located inside of master closet centered on pocket door
- 5. In spare bedroom, remove small/upper left-side window
- 6. In main bath, add 24" x 12" crank-out awning window as high up on wall as possible. (Note: It may not be possible to find a 12" high unit; smallest I've been able to find is 16" high)
- 7. Extend right wall of house/garage out 2', so that total house width is 34'
 - a. In master bedroom, replace single small/upper right-side window with two 16" double-hung windows that have 8' of wall space between the two windows
 - b. Remove tub/shower from master bath
 - i. Use ½ of that space for linen closet on the inside of main bath
 - ii. Use the other ½ of that tub/shower space for a raceway to run 6" metalbestos chimney up to roof from cellar
 - iii. Change master bath to pocket door
 - c. Extend width of vanity in main bath proportionally
- 8. Combine the original linen and hall closets into one larger hall closet with bi-fold doors
- 9. Include plumbing hookups and dryer vent for laundry in cellar below bathrooms
- 10. Remove outdoor deck and kitchen island

Questions:

- 1. As designed, 2x4 or 2x6 construction?
- 2. Where is the furnace vent/chimney located?
- 3. What are the dimensions of the main/master bathrooms?
- 4. What is the width of main and master bath doors?
- 5. Where does the fan/vent for the main bath exit?
- 6. With house width change, what is the pitch on the roof?
- 7. How deep are the front/rear eves?
- 8. Do bedroom windows on rear of house meet NH egress code requirements?
