Hi Jay,

It was nice talking with you 2 days ago. Sorry for sending the list late as it is Chinese New Year here, the most important holiday for Chinese.

Before I start the list, I would like to make sure all parties including the architect are clear about our objectives so that there is no confusion going forward. We are building a house to meet <u>our needs</u> instead of accommodating the land or space. We rely on the the architect's knowledge and expertise to propose different options for us to consider. We will not be able to make any decisions until we see some solid floor plans that can accommodate the majority of our needs.

Here is the must-haves list.

General Requirements

- Would like the ceiling on all levels to be at least 9 feet and prefer 10 feet at level 2.

- Need central A/C Heat.

- 5. Wine storage room
- 6. Storage
- 7. Bathroom with shower
- 8. Stone patio under the deck for baby to scooter around.

Level 2

- 1. Mudroom with space for coat hangers and big shoe cabinets for storage
- 2. Living room (Cathedral or vaulted Ceiling?) with fireplace
- 3. Kitchen + Dining area (Cathedral or vaulted Ceiling?)
- Need to walk out to the deck from the dining area. See attached photo for reference.
- 4. A small bar area in the dining space
- 5. Walk-in Pantry
- 6. 1 En-Suite bedroom
- 7. Playroom for baby
- 8. Laundry room
- Need space for sink, hanging clothes and additional smaller washer for intimates
- 9. half bath
- 10. Storage
- 11. Deck
- Would like to see options including wrap around.
- Need to be able to access back yard from the deck.

Level 3

- 1. Master bedroom with 2 walk-in-closets + Master bath
- The walk-in-closets don't have to be 2 separate rooms. Could be 1 big closet with 2 different areas.
- Would like to have 2 windows at the corner of the room with a fireplace in the middle. **See attached photo for idea.**
- 2. Two en-suite bedrooms
- Need 1 of them to be right next to the master bedroom as this will be the nursery.

- Need a bathtub in the nursery.
- The other bedroom only needs a shower.
- 3. Study
- 4. Loft area for lounging/reading
- 5. Storage

Hope this list can give the architect a clear idea of what we want. Before we schedule the next meeting, we would like to get a few floor plan options for review, That will allow us to have a more productive meeting.
